#### Committee Purpose

Track legislation that impacts the construction industry, and coordinate AGC's response. This is an advisory committee.

#### Activities/Deliverables

- Prepare an annual work plan for Executive Board approval.
- Review legislative matters involving construction or construction-related activities at the local, state and federal levels.
- Develop legislative priorities and propose AGC of Alaska positions.
- Coordinate advocacy efforts to support AGC's legislative priorities, including the annual Legislative Fly-In.
- Hold regular meetings to share information.
- Meet regularly with AGC's lobbyist.

#### Membership

Any AGC of Alaska Member with operations impacted by legislation, interest in and experience in advocacy, and/or relationships with elected officials.

#### Staff Support

The committee has a staff member assigned to:

- Organize committee meetings, including preparing the agenda (with Chair input) and writing the meeting notes/minutes (with Chair approval).
- Compile biannual reports to the Board.
- Manage the position development process, including circulating drafts and tracking versions.
- Work with other AGC staff to calendar and organize events.



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## **Meeting Schedule**

The committee meets monthly during the legislative session, with additional meetings called as needed to respond to issues.
