Committee Purpose

Advocate for education, training and scholarships while highlighting opportunities for industry to connect with educators and students. The goal is to build and promote a strong and sustainable skilled construction workforce. This is an advisory committee.

Activities/Deliverables

- Prepare an annual work plan for Executive Board approval.
- Hold regular meetings to share information.
- Continue efforts to get into classrooms and deliver message about construction operations in our state. Maintain the “Contractor’s Playbook” for engaging with students in classrooms. Audit playbook and resources/links annually.
- Advise school districts and the University of Alaska on development and implementation of construction-related curriculum.
- Select annual scholarship recipients.
- Provide input to the Conference Committee on relevant conference topics and speakers.

Membership

Any current AGC member or designee with an interest in workforce development issues.

Staff Support

The committee has a staff member assigned to:

- Organize committee meetings, including preparing the agenda (with Chair input) and writing the meeting notes/minutes (with Chair approval).
- Compile biannual reports to the Board.
- Research workforce development issues.
- Work with other AGC staff to calendar and organize events.
- Execute projects and plan events.
