Alaska DOT&PF Northern Region presenting on the upcoming Airport Way/Steese Expressway Intersection project (GARS)

Friday, December 10, 1:00 to 2:00 PM Fairbanks AGC Office

Alaska DOT&PF Northern Region staff will present on the upcoming [Airport Way/Steese Expressway Intersection](#) project, also known as GARS. The project is scheduled to advertise for bids in January 2022. The purpose of the presentation is to help the contracting community better understand why the at-grade alternative was selected, how it operates (and why it's efficient, even with all those signals), plan for maintenance, and answer any construction related questions. The presentation won't take the full hour, so staff will be available to discuss any other issues of interest.

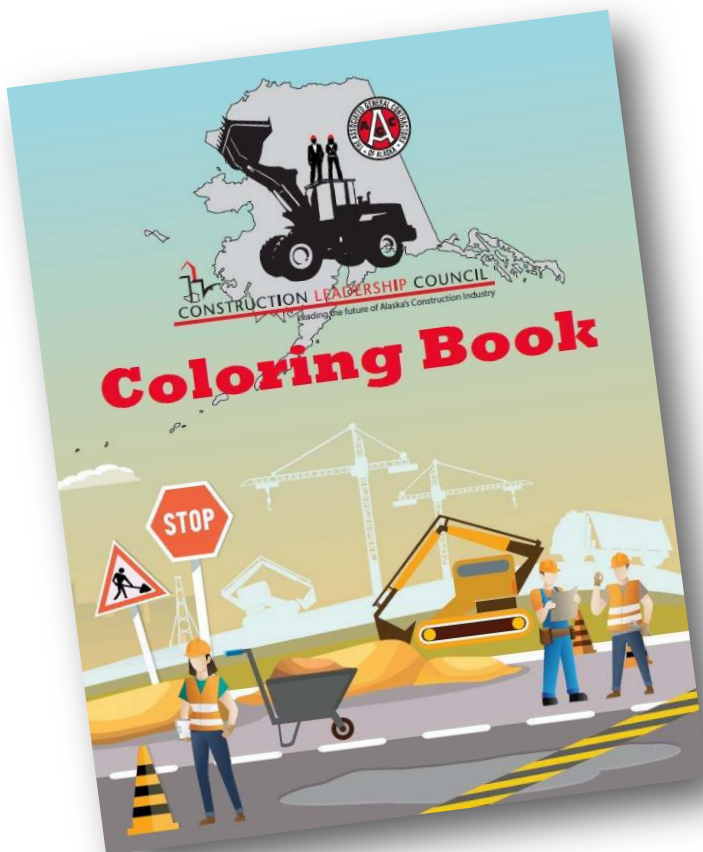
