

Anchorage Training – AK CESCL 8hr Registration Form

ALASKA CERTIFIED EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL LEAD

The Associated General Contractors of Alaska, working with the USACE Alaska District, ADOT & PF, ADEC, ADNR, ARRC, MOA and other Alaskan construction industry representatives have developed a Certified Erosion and Sediment Control Lead (AK-CESCL) training program for Alaska.

The course is designed for commercial and residential builders and explains the erosion process and how to obtain and comply with the EPA NPDES stormwater permit. The course also describes the key elements of a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and provides detailed instructions on how to maintain a SWPPP, select, install and maintain stormwater Best Management (BMP's). AGC's AK-CESCL certification class will give you the tools you need to comply with federal, state, and local stormwater requirements. This AK-CESCL class will meet requirements for recertification.

- **As of February 20th, 2018 an AK CESCL certified individual may now renew certification within the new approved grace period of 90 calendar days from the expiration date of their certificate. During the 90 day grace period, a certified individual is eligible to renew his or her AK CESCL certification by taking the refresher course. During the grace period the individual is considered not certified for purposes of being a “qualified person” and for purposes of “permit requirements”. The approved grace period is for 90 days not 91.**
- **Payment is due at time of registration.** Cancellations require 2 working days’ notice prior to course date. **Late cancellations and no-shows are non-refundable.**
- **MEMBERS ONLY:** You may request to be invoiced but check must be received no later than first day of class.
- Registration is first come/first serve – We reserve the right to cancel or postpone the scheduled class if minimum participation of 15 students is not met 2 weeks prior to scheduled training.
- After January 1, 2008, the USACE Alaska District and ADOT & PF are requiring Contractors on their construction projects to have a certified CESCL representative on site.

AK-CESCL Eight-Hour Refresher Course

NEW – The Alaska Storm Water Steering Committee (ASWSC) has approved a one-day, eight-hour **Refresher Course** to satisfy the Alaska Certified Erosion Sediment Control Lead (AK-CESCL) renewal requirements. To be eligible to take this training, you must have an active AK-CESCL certification and have taken the two-day (16-hour) class within the last three years. **If your AK-CESCL card is expired, you are required to take the two-day class to obtain a new certification.**

Who Should Attend the Refresher Course: This new course is an advanced training designed for participants who are familiar with the Alaska Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (APDES) Construction General Permit. The course curricula emphasize the terminology of the CGP along with principles and practices of erosion and sediment control, best management practices (BMPs), Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) requirements, and inspection protocols needed to stay compliant with the CGP.

This course is a summary of the two-day initial AK-CESCL class. This course thoroughly examines erosion and sediment pollution control concepts and design procedures as they apply to construction projects. The Refresher Course is a training and certification program to comply with the CGP. The Refresher Course will stress risk management, review proper best management practices, and provide guidance.

Testing and Certification Requirements: At the end of the class you will be required to take a 25 question test. This is a closed book, closed neighbor, timed test. You will need to receive a 72% or higher on the test to pass this class. Upon passing the eight-hour refresher course, the applicant will be granted a new AK-CESCL certification. If the applicant does not receive a passing score, the student will be required to retake the two-day (16-hour) class at their own expense.

Reasonable accommodations: To be eligible for a reasonable accommodation under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), you must (1) be qualified to perform the essential functions of your position and (2) have a qualifying disability that limits a major life function.
