### SAFETY STAND-DOWN ON SAFETY RELATED TOPIC OF CHOICE

This information is to help you organize your Stand-Down. This is a suggested agenda for the onsite supervision. Please review prior to facilitating the material.

#### Step 1 - Pre-Planning:

- Review and become familiar with Safety Related Topic of Choice
- Review topic with jobsite leadership
- Assemble your team during the week of May 4-8, 2020.
- Large projects may pick a few spots to hold smaller meetings (i.e. break into manageable groups of 25-30 people)

#### Step 2 - Purpose for the Stand-Down:

- Demonstrate a strong commitment to safety
- Identify and control unsafe work practices and conditions
- Communicate awareness through ownership and employee involvement

#### Step 3 - Implementation:

- Introduce Purpose of the Stand-Down (Step 2)
- Break into manageable crews
- Review topic with each group
- Have each group audit their respective work areas identifying hazards
- Have group leaders collect audit information, and return to job team for summary.
- **Take photo for Photo Contest (see rules below).**

#### Step 4 - Group Summary:

- Review a Safety Related Topic of Choice with all groups
- Ask group for solutions to these hazards

#### Step 5 - Close Stand-Down
